Come together with other parents or caregivers and children weekly to experience a warm, peaceful morning facilitated by a Waldorf Early Childhood Teacher. We will explore life and parenting while creating community, nurturing our children and one another in an atmosphere of respect and support.

An appreciation of each child's unique unfolding development sets a mood of wonder, reverence and enthusiasm. We will explore child development and early childhood educational principles using a Waldorf approach in light of the practical aspects of parenting/caregiving. We'll share conversation about creative discipline, nurturing environments for children, the importance of play and share our questions.

As we observe the children playing, we will support their development as they explore their environment, build their imaginations and navigate social interactions.

Our mornings together will include free play, parent conversation and handcrafts, time to observe, healthy snacks, circle time, puppetry and outdoor play.

Fall classes begin:

October 21, 2010.

We will meet for 8 Fridays, with the exception of the Friday following Thanksgiving.

Tuition: \$224 for 8-week session (or \$14/hour)

If you sign up and bring in a friend, you get 20% off your tuition (\$224 becomes \$180)
You could choose to share that with your friend, making the tuition only \$202 for each of you.
